- **assistance in accessing documentation** is provided at the university library (Assas, Vaugirard 1, Melun, etc.). When the library is full, priority is given to disabled students;
- visually impaired or blind students have access to adapted equipment in certain centres (screen magnifiers, scanner, Braille display, voice summary);
- the provision of note-takers;

The Relais handicap santé favours finding notetakers among the students who are on the same courses as the disabled student. It also favours computer note-taking so that the lessons can be sent directly by email to the student.

- some lectures are filmed and accessible online. The list of these lessons is available on your Digital Working Environment (ENT):
 ent.u-paris2.fr;
- the provision of a personalised tutoring system. The Relais handicap santé favours the support and individualised help of a tutor in the first year of the degree course. This is usually a Masters 2 student whose task is to provide educational and methodological support for students with disabilities.

Arrangement for examinations

In accordance with the French Education Code (art. L. 112-4), disabled students or students with a disabling health problem can benefit from accommodations for taking their exams.

You can obtain extra time to write an exam (one-third extra time: 1 hour extra for 3-hour

tests, 1/2 hour for 1.5-hour tests). In addition, you can take the exams in a room made available especially for you and, depending on the medical service's recommendations, you will have access to an assistant, enlarged handouts, the provision of a computer supplied by the university's IT department, or any other measure justified by your disability.

In order to facilitate organisation between departments, your request for accommodation (studies and exams) must be completed before end of October for regular courses and before early November for digital courses for the first semester. Please note that applications made after these dates will be validated only during the second semester.

Furthermore, the deadline for applications for the second semester will be specified at the end of 2023 and will be accessible on the applications webpage.

Accommodation and Financial Aid

To benefit from a grant and adapted accommodation, you must submit a student social application (DSE) at the CROUS in Paris between mid-January and the end of April for the following academic year.


The Relais handicap santé can help you in your efforts to obtain financial support.

Different types of aid exist, such as higher education grants awarded on the basis of social criteria: these enable their beneficiaries to undertake higher education studies after secondary education, or some time later, as without this aid, they would have been forced to give up their studies because of their social situation. Applications must be renewed every year.

To facilitate access to higher education for handicapped students with motor and visual disabilities, Crous de Paris has established a specific procedure for staying in university hostels.

If you are in this situation, you can occupy a hostel from your first year of study for a period that extends up to 5 years.

In order to best cater to your accessibility requirements or for special arrangements made on a case-by-case basis, a Crous social worker is in charge of monitoring this system.

To access this service, contact also the social service between January and April for an interview when you apply for accommodation via the student social application (DSE).

Your admission to the hostel is subject to approval by a specialised committee.
